

THREE-CARD POKER, SIX-CARD BONUS

Three-Card Poker is a form of Stud Poker. The game is comprised of two independent betting options.

RULES OF THE GAME:

RANKING OF HANDS FROM HIGHEST TO LOWEST:

Straight Flush/Three of a Kind/Straight/Flush/Pair

If no hand contains a pair or better, the hand that contains the highest ranking card(s) wins. Ace is high, except in a 3 – 2 – A sequence.

BET ON YOUR OWN HAND

Bet just the Pair Plus spot to play your hand value only and not against the Dealer's hand. If your hand contains a Pair or better, YOU WIN!

BET AGAINST THE DEALER'S HAND

The Ante allows you to play against the Dealer. After you look at your three-card hand, you have two options. You can fold, or if you think your hand is high enough to beat the Dealer, you can place an equal wager on the Play spot. If your hand beats the Dealer's qualifying hand of a Queen or better, YOU WIN BOTH WAGERS. If the Dealer does not qualify, you win the Ante wager and the Player wager is a push.

PLAYING AGAINST THE DEALER

Players who fold their hand lose. When the Dealer does not qualify, Play is a push and Ante wins 1 to 1. When the Dealer qualifies and the Player's hand beats the Dealer's hand, Play wins even money (1 to 1) and Ante wins 1 to 1. A tie is a push.

SIX-CARD BONUS

Three-Card Poker, Six-Card Bonus features an optional bonus side bet. This side bet is based on the best five-card poker hand that can be made from the six cards dealt to the Dealer and Player. Thus, each Player uses his own three cards and combines them with the Dealer's three cards. This Player is eligible to win this wager even if he folds his Ante/Play wager. This side bet is paid according to a posted pay table. Players must make their standard wagers and, if they like, the Six-Card Bonus Wager.

ANTE BONUS PAYOUTS

When wagering against the Dealer, the Ante Bonus payouts will be paid according to a posted pay table.

PAIR PLUS PAYOUTS

Are paid according to a posted pay table.

BET BOTH

Bet Ante and Pair Plus to play both. If a Player has placed an Ante Wager and a Pair Plus wager but does not make a Play wager, the Player forfeits the Ante and Pair Plus wagers.
